## Institute for Health Metrics and Evaluation at the University of Washington (IHME) COVID-19 Hospital Forecasting

## Statewide Conference Call Summaries from Thursday, April 9, 2020

Calls today focused on Nursing Homes, Home Health and community Healthcare Partners

AHCA continues to work with CMS to provide flexibility so that you can continue to provide services, including the ability to provide telemedicine services. Telemedicine information can be found on the AHCA website here [FAQs](#)

N95 masks are for healthcare workers and require special fit testing. CDC has guidance for making and wear face coverings. When you are working with clients/patients, a mask should be worn. Handwashing is also very important and regular cleaning of equipment. Do not work if you are sick.

AHCA and FDOH is working to identify peak demand for hospital services. It is also important to focus on the continuum of care. How do we make sure that the most vulnerable that rely on home based services are provided the services they need while maintaining the infection control practices in the home care setting to protect those most vulnerable.

Agencies providing care to patients in an assisted living facility should continue to provide these services. Staff going into these facilities must be screened, but the care should continue to occur. Masks should be worn when providing these services. If staff is sick, they must not work to serve these individuals.

AHCA continues to work with CMS to provide flexibility so that you can continue to provide services, including the ability to provide telemedicine services.

The Governor's Executive Order that defines essential services should allow healthcare staff the ability to travel to and from work and to provide services for clients/patients. Staff members should carry ID badges with them as they travel.

If a healthcare worker shows symptoms, they must be tested before returning to work. Contact the county health department for assistance in obtaining testing. County health departments may have a faster turnaround time for test results for healthcare workers.

If a facility is on lockdown and staff passes screening but still is not allowed to enter to provide services, contact regional AHCA representative and/or CHD to work through the process.

Surgical masks can be worn for a day, if not soiled., but gloves should be changed between encounters. Cloth masks should be washed daily.
