Statewide Conference Call Summaries

- Questions from healthcare facilities should go through the appropriate licensing unit for the facility type
- Continue to recognize the importance of public health practices and mitigation measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19; there is no vaccine or treatments, so prevention is the key
- Masks in the Home Health and Assisted Living Setting: This is a very important issue, as some people can be asymptomatic carriers. Those caring for the elderly and vulnerable populations should wear masks. Surgical procedure masks can be worn all day, if they are not soiled
- We are currently working in an environment that is disruptive to the delivery of services and support of the most vulnerable citizens in our state. We are having to think differently about how we can reach out and continue care for these clients.
- Counties in south Florida are seeing an increase in surge at the hospitals. All of the efforts to reduce spread in the community, the increase surge at hospitals, and the risk and rate of transmission in sub-acute facilities and providers has domino effect across the continuum of care. We must think differently to protect the most vulnerable
- To increase staffing numbers, AHCA is working with LTC Associations to create expedited training program to assist new hires serve as CNAs at LTC facilities
- Federal Government is making changes to Medicaid and Medicare to help the State respond easier
- There are county-level conversations across the continuum of care for surge planning, etc. Providers should be aware of the discussions happening in your counties and understand the ripple effect of surge in your community. Contact your local EOC (Emergency Operations Center) and County Health Department to engage in the conversation
- AHCA is looking to extend or provide flexibility for facility licensure and other regulatory aspects. Contact licensing office with specific concerns
- Encouraging home health to provide telehealth options when possible
- Staff should be encouraged to WASH hands between patients using soap and water instead of sanitizer
- If staff is sick, it is very important to not expose yourself to the vulnerable and elderly
