  the process to distribute the remaining supplies for care packages to member Home Health
  and Hospice agencies.
- Staff previously presented the CDBG: Mitigiation Grant application to the members. The NEFRC
  was invited to present he application to the review panel. Staff will continue to update the
  Board as the process continues.
- Staff is working on developing a Training webpage Because face-to-face training is not possible while dealing with COVID, online and virtual training will be offered to members.
- The Florida Hospital Association, FHA, is opartnering with the Florida Healthcare Coalitions on ASPR funded projects to improve the response capability to highly infectious diseases. More information will come in the future.
